CEMETERY FEES 2019 - 2020

From November 2019

Part A (Note 1)

Interment Fees (payable whether or not an exclusive right of burial has been granted)

For the interment of:-

i) Body of a still-born child or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed one month	£35
ii) Body of child whose age at the time of death exceeded one month, or an adult	£68
iii) Additional charge where the interment is at a depth exceeding 5ft	£127
iv) Cremated remains	£85

Part B

Fees for the Exclusive Right of Burial in Earthen graves (for a period of 99 years)

i) In a child's grave	£98
ii) In a single space up to 5ft. deep	£255
iii) In a single space over 5ft. deep (double depth grave)	£340
iv) In a space for cremated remains (3ft x 2ft)	£83

Part C

Fees for the right to place headstones, vases, tablets, monuments and monumental inscriptions on graves (a grant of exclusive right of burial must be obtained before the following will be approved)

i) Headstone not exceeding 1ft. high	£61
ii) Headstone not exceeding 2ft. high	£82
iii) Headstone not exceeding 3ft. high	£82
iv) Vase not exceeding 12" high	£61
v) Tablet 16" x 16" on a grave in a garden of remembrance	£61
vi) A flat stone, single grave	£61
vii) A flat stone double grave	£119
viii) Other monuments not exceeding 3ft. high	£82
ix) Charge for each additional inscription (the fees above include the first inscription)	£61
x) A flat-based memorial plaque on a cremation plot must not exceed the size of the plot. A specified height gradient must not exceed more than one inch.	£61

Information for non-residents of Lyddington

Requests for a grave space or to reserve a plot in the New Cemetery, Lyddington, for a non-resident will be considered on a case by case basis. Fees imposed for adult non-residents will remain in line with fees charged by Uppingham Town Council.
